

Towing of Trailers

Below is a chart providing specific information regarding what types of trailers a specific vehicle is allowed to tow. The determination regarding what is legally allowed is based upon how the vehicle and trailer are registered.

Note:

- The trailer registration certificate, or a copy thereof, must be carried in or upon the trailer, or in or upon the motor vehicle, which is towing or parking the trailer.
- The registration certificate for a fertilizer trailer shall be kept at the principal plate of business of the owner of the fertilizer trailer.
- The registration certificate for a trailer towed by a public power district (PPD) or metropolitan utilities district (MUD) shall be kept at the principal place of business of the PPD or MUD.
