

NEBRASKA'S NEW DRIVER LICENSE AND ID CARDS ARE HERE!

Nebraska has introduced a new generation of driver licenses and state identification cards designed to enhance security, durability, and ease of verification for businesses and institutions that rely on trusted identity credentials.

What's New and Why it Matters

New Card Construction

Nebraska's new credentials are produced using 100% polycarbonate, a material recognized for its strength and security. Unlike traditional layered cards, polycarbonate cards are formed as a single solid structure, making them extremely difficult to alter or separate.

Why this matters for verifiers:

- Increased resistance to bending, peeling, and delamination
- Longer card lifespan with less visible wear makes verification easier
- Stronger protection against counterfeit modifications resulting in a more trusted credential

Laser-Engraved Photograph

The cardholder's photograph is laser-engraved directly into the card body, rather than printed or layered. Any attempt to tamper with the image will be easily noticed by authenticators.

Verification advantages:

- Clear, high-contrast image that remains visible in low-light conditions for easy verification
- A Secondary photo flips based on viewing angle, a security feature that is extremely difficult and costly to replicate
- Textured elements embedded in the card allow for easy verification and trust when handling the credential


