COMMERCIAL LEARNERS PERMIT (CLP) CHANGES EFFECTIVE 9/2/2023

The following changes to Commercial Learners Permit (CLP) documents will go into effect on September 2, 2023:

- CLP documents issued on or after 9/2/2023 will be valid for one year from the date of issuance.
- CLP documents will not be eligible for renewal after 9/1/2023.

Some important items to note:

- Skills test results are valid for six months and must be passed on the same CLP.
- Passed knowledge tests are valid for six months.
- CLP documents can change class or add/remove endorsements and restrictions.
- CLP documents cannot be renewed.

Frequently Asked Questions:

Q: After 9/2/2023, will I need to retest if my CLP expires and I apply for a new CLP?

A: Yes, when CLP knowledge tests were passed six months or more prior.

Q: My CLP will expire after 9/2/2023. Can it be renewed?

A: No. After 9/2/2023, there will not be an option to renew any CLP documents.

Q: If I took the CLP knowledge tests, will I need to retake them to get a new CLP after 9/2/2023?

A: CLP knowledge tests are valid for six months from the date they are passed. If it has been less than six months since a knowledge test was passed, retaking that test will not be required for a new CLP. If it has been more than six months since the knowledge test was passed, that test will need to be retaken and passed prior to issuance of the new CLP.

Q: How long are passed knowledge test results valid?

A: Six months.

Q: If I took part of the CDL skills test but have since obtained a new CLP, will that passed portion of the test count when I return to test?

A: No. If a new CLP document is issued, any previously passed portions of the CDL skills test are not valid and will need to be retaken.
