

Instructions for Making Application for Creation of a Specialty License Plate Design for an Organization

- 1. Complete an Application for Creation of a Specialty License Plate Design for an Organization. Complete the Certification portion in full, sign in front of a notary public and submit to the DMV with the following items:
 - A copy of the organization's articles of incorporation and, if the organization consists of a group of nonprofit corporations, a copy for each organization;
 - A copy of the organization's charter or bylaws and, if the organization consists of a group of nonprofit corporations, a copy for each organization;
 - Any Internal Revenue Service rulings of the organization's nonprofit taxexempt status and, if the organization consists of a group of nonprofit corporations, a copy for each organization;
 - A copy of a certificate of existence on file with the Secretary of State under the Nebraska Nonprofit Corporation Act for the organization and, if the organization consists of a group of nonprofit corporations, a copy for each organization.
- 2. Wait for certification to be received from the DMV. This may take up to four weeks.
- 3. Upon receipt of notification of DMV certification, an electronic version of your plate design must be submitted to the DMV (if one was not submitted with application). The design must be submitted a minimum of 12 weeks prior to submission of submission of 250 pre-paid applications.
- 4. Upon receipt of notification of approval of plate design, submit a minimum of 250 prepaid applications from individuals for purchase or your organization's specialty plate. Applications must be submitted with one payment for a minimum of \$17,500 (\$70 per application).

The DMV will certify/deny applications within four weeks of submission.

- All documentation as detailed on page 2 of this application is attached.

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

The following documents must be submitted with this Application for Creation of a Specialty License Plate Design for an Organization:

- A copy of the organization's articles of incorporation and, if the organization consists of a group of nonprofit corporations, a copy for each organization;
- A copy of the organization's charter or bylaws and, if the organization consists of a group of nonprofit corporations, a copy for each organization;
- Any Internal Revenue Service rulings of the organization's nonprofit tax-exempt status and, if the organization consists of a group of nonprofit corporations, a copy for each organization;
- A copy of a certificate of existence on file with the Secretary of State under the Nebraska Nonprofit Corporation Act for the organization and, if the organization consists of a group of nonprofit corporations, a copy for each organization.

IMPORTANT: Two hundred fifty prepaid applications for the organization specific license plates must be submitted after DMV's certification of the specialty license plates for this organization.

PROCESS OVERVIEW

The DMV will accept applications on an on-going, continuous basis. Upon receipt of the application an acknowledgement of receipt or a request for additional information/documentation will be forwarded to the address on the Application.

Certification/denial of the applications will occur within four weeks of receipt.

Upon certification of an organization, the organization shall gather and submit to the DMV 250 pre-paid applications for numeric organization-specific specialty license plates. The individual applications must be submitted with one check from the organization for the total amount (\$70 per plate, a minimum of \$17,500). Upon receipt of the 250 applications and fee an organization's specialty license plate design will be opened to the public for purchase.

An electronic version of the suggested design of the license plate may either be submitted at the time of application or after certification. The design must be submitted at least 12 weeks prior to submission of the 250 pre-paid applications; certified organizations must notify the DMV when they have pre-sold 200 plates to provide ample time for the DMV to prepare systems, etc.

Please Read Carefully

<u>Applicant Information</u>: Provide the name of the registered owner of the vehicle indicated in the Vehicle Information portion of the application.

<u>Vehicle Information</u>: Applicant must have a Nebraska issued title in their name on the vehicle. Two exceptions to this requirement are leased vehicles and non-resident military. For leased vehicles the leasing company must have obtained a Nebraska title in their name for the vehicle and the applicant must indicate the vehicle is leased and provide the name of the leasing company. Non-resident military must provide a copy of vehicle's current registration. Applicant's applying for organizational license plates on more than one vehicle must submit a separate application for each vehicle.

<u>Name of Organization</u>: Indicate the name of the organization-specific plate design for which this application is submitted.

Date and sign the application form.

Upon completion, this application shall be submitted to the organization making application to the DMV for approval of an organizational license plate design. The organization will submit the application to the DMV, with the remainder of the initial 250 applications and one check from the organization for the total amount (\$70.00 per plate, a minimum of \$17,500).

Once the 250-application minimum is met, all applications will be processed, and the applicants will receive an approval notification from the DMV. The notification indicates the date the plates will be available at the County Treasurer's office. If an email address is provided you will receive notification when the plates are received at the County Treasurer's Office. Current plates and registration must be surrendered when the organizational license plates are registered. Additional fees for production of the license plates and new registration will be charged.

The actual plate size is $11.94^{\circ} \times 5.96^{\circ}$ with a $3/10^{\circ}$ rim around the edge of the plate where no printing can occur. Two locations, at the top right-hand corner and top-left hand corner, are reserved for the placement of validation and tonnage decals. Decals are $1\frac{1}{2}^{\circ} \times 1^{\circ}$ in size.

The word "Nebraska" must appear between the top two boltholes, a wide array of fonts are available but must be at least .75" in height. Plate numbers will be printed in the color of the current plate series (rotates between black, blue, and green).

A name, motto, adage, etc. may be placed across the bottom of the plate between the two bolt holes. A logo no larger than 3 ½" x 4 ¼" may be placed at the right or left-hand side.

Submitting the design in a layered .psd file (cmyk format) is preferred. A layered .psd file will reduce the changes made to the design by the DMV. Electronic file of design may be emailed to <u>dmv.dvrweb@nebraska.gov</u>.

The design of the plate MUST make readability a priority. The Department will make the final decision on readability, colors, etc.
