

OBJECTION TO DETERMINATION OF MOTOR VEHICLE TAX

Any person or taxing official may file an objection within ten (10) days after the September Manufactured Suggested Retail Price (MSRP) determination has been certified by the Director.

or

Any affected person may file an objection to the MSRP determination of the Director not more than fifteen (15) days before an not later than thirty (30) days after the registration date for the particular motor vehicle that is the subject of the objection. All pleadings shall be filed with the Department at the Legal Division, Department of Motor Vehicles, 301 Centennial Mall South, P.O. Box 94699, Lincoln, NE 68509-4699. Filing may be accomplished by personal delivery or mail and will be received during the Department's regular office hours.
