# LEGISLATIVE UPDATE

- 2019 Legislation
- Previous years' legislative changes effective with VicToRy deployment
  - Collection of DOT number at time of registration
  - Paper title not required for the following:
    - Changing title owner name to reflect a legal change of name
    - Removing an owner name with consent of all co-owners and lienholders
    - Adding an additional owner name with consent of all co-owners and lienholders
    - Repossession
  - Eliminates requirement for odometer reading to be reported as part of the repossession title issuance process. The reading from the previous transaction will be carried forward to the new title issued.

# LEGISLATIVE UPDATE

- Previous years' legislative changes effective with VicToRy deployment, cont.
  - An owner may voluntarily update his or her address on a registration upon payment of a fee of \$1.50 (plus \$5.50 for issuance of registration).
  - Requires wrecker or salvage dealers to electronically report junked vehicle and boat information to the DMV electronically.
  - Requires insurance companies to electronically report owner-retained boat and vehicle information to the DMV electronically.

# DMV UPDATES

  - New Contract
    - Equipment

    - Effective July 1, 2019 – increasing from \$2.50 to \$4.50
