Nebraska's New DMV System

System Verification, Take Two

February 11-22 will mark VicToRy's second and final System Verification session. Similar to the October session in organization and structure, February's System Verification will contain additional content, as more of the system will be configured. We have invited October's verifiers back for February, as their experience working in the system will prove beneficial during this more comprehensive session. After System Verification, additional testing will take place in the form of Business Testing, where the system will be evaluated at a granular level, and End-to-End testing, where whole processes will be tested. These latter testing sessions will start in April and July, respectively. Information about sign-ups will be sent in early 2019.

Expert Users

We are looking for volunteers to smooth the transition to the new system by becoming Expert Users in VicToRy. Expert Users will receive training in Lincoln for one month with travel and lodging covered by the DMV. They will then take the knowledge they have gained and train county staff at locations in each NACO district.
