Training Tiers 1 & 2

Training is fast approaching! Thank you to everyone for submitting your training registrations. With these responses, the FAST Training team has scheduled classes for everyone who will have access to VicToRy. Prior to classroom training, which will begin in August, users will have the opportunity to get acquainted with the system through interactive videos, also known as computer-based training (CBT) modules. Tier-1 CBT modules will focus on system fundamentals while Tier-2 CBT modules will cover job-specific tasks. These CBT modules are the building blocks of training and further support your transition from VTR to VicToRy.

Friendly Fleet Facts

A fleet in VTR groups together renewals for processing. Going forward, VicToRy will continue to group multiple vehicles together through a quick and easy renewal process. Additionally, VicToRy has its own fleet functionality that is available for business entities with an FEIN and 25 or more vehicles, excluding snowmobiles, campers, and boats. Unlike today in VTR, once a fleet is created in VicToRy, that grouping of vehicles will be available to renew in the county and online indefinitely.

The Sandbox

One of the best ways to familiarize yourself with the VicToRy system is to play around in the Sandbox, a practice environment that will be available from August 12th to October 11th. The best way to utilize this training tool is to take paperwork from the previous week that you've already processed in VTR and re-process it in the Sandbox. Every Monday the data in the Sandbox will reset with a fresh copy from VTR. What you do in the Sandbox won't affect any real records, but it will allow you to practice completing your usual tasks in the new system, helping you to build confidence that will last you through training, rollout, and beyond.

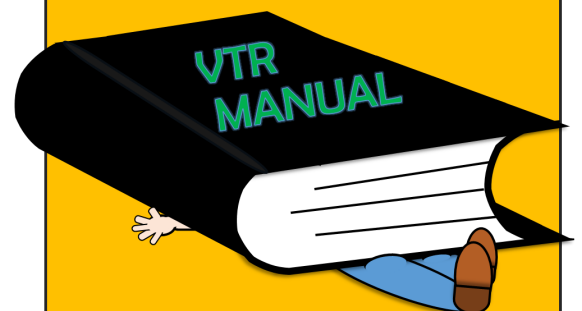

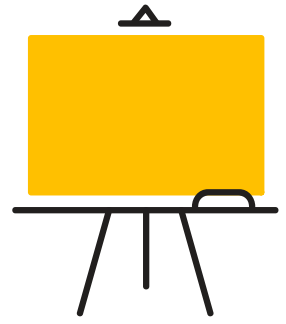
