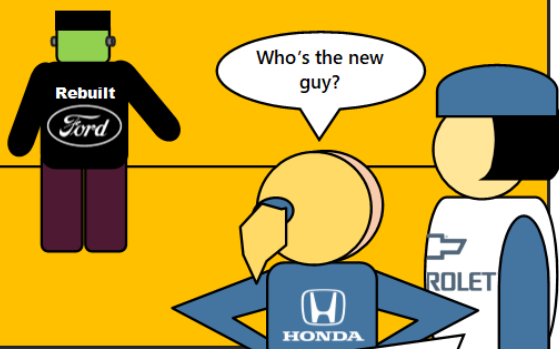

Conversion Verification

Conversion Verification is well underway! Conversion Verification is the visual inspection of data that has been extracted from the legacy systems and converted into VicToRy. This analysis ensures data is being brought over to VicToRy correctly, allowing the Nebraska county treasurers and DMV to continue serving customers seamlessly and efficiently. The work of our Conversion Verifiers is crucial, as all of the records in VicToRy on Day 1 of Go-Live will be converted data from legacy systems.

Daniele Galloway is a conversion data verifier comparing legacy information with the converted data to identify any discrepancies between the two sets of records. On the FAST side, KC Tan and Kenny Patrick analyze, transform, and load data from legacy into the new system. When VicToRy goes live next year, every record in the system will be a converted record. The work completed by the conversion team and others will provide the entire state with clean, accurate data that will promote a smooth transition from legacy to VicToRy.
