System Verification

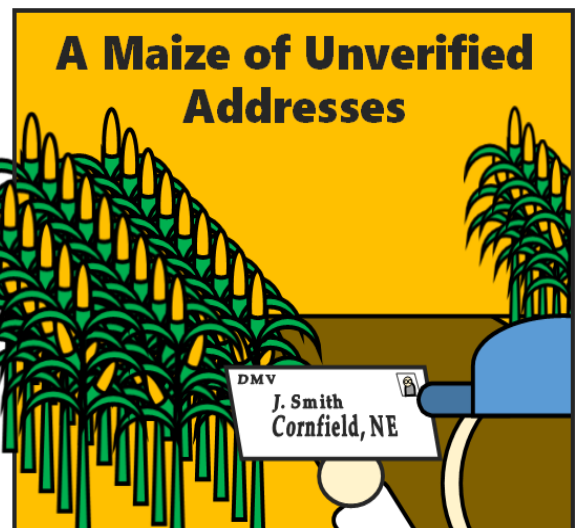
The first System Verification session will take place October 15 – 26, 2018. System Verification is meant to give end users an early opportunity to explore the system and ensure it is being configured to meet your business process needs. Verifiers will spend two weeks on the VicToRy project in Lincoln learning how to navigate VicToRy, testing existing configuration, and verifying the system is working as expected. Thank you to the many volunteers and the 13 county treasurers and staff who will participate.

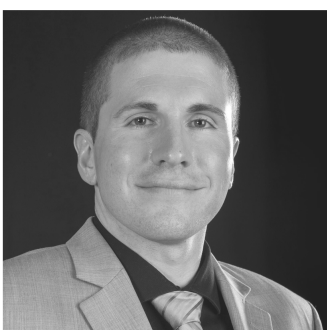
Question: What is your favorite thing about living in Nebraska?
