## End-to-End Testing

The second session of Business Testing is underway. Groups of testers will rotate through the project, evaluating the system until June 21st, after which we will bid them farewell and welcome our End-to-End testers on July 1st. Rather than testing the system at a granular level, the End-to-End testers will evaluate entire processes from beginning to end. Tester feedback will provide further opportunities for the developers to ensure that everything is running smoothly come October 15th, 2019.

## Training Registration

Registration for Tier-3 training will begin this month. All county treasurer and Help Desk staff are required to attend a 2-day County Class. An additional 1-day Manager Class will also be available for designated staff. DMV staff will be required to attend training for their specific business unit.
